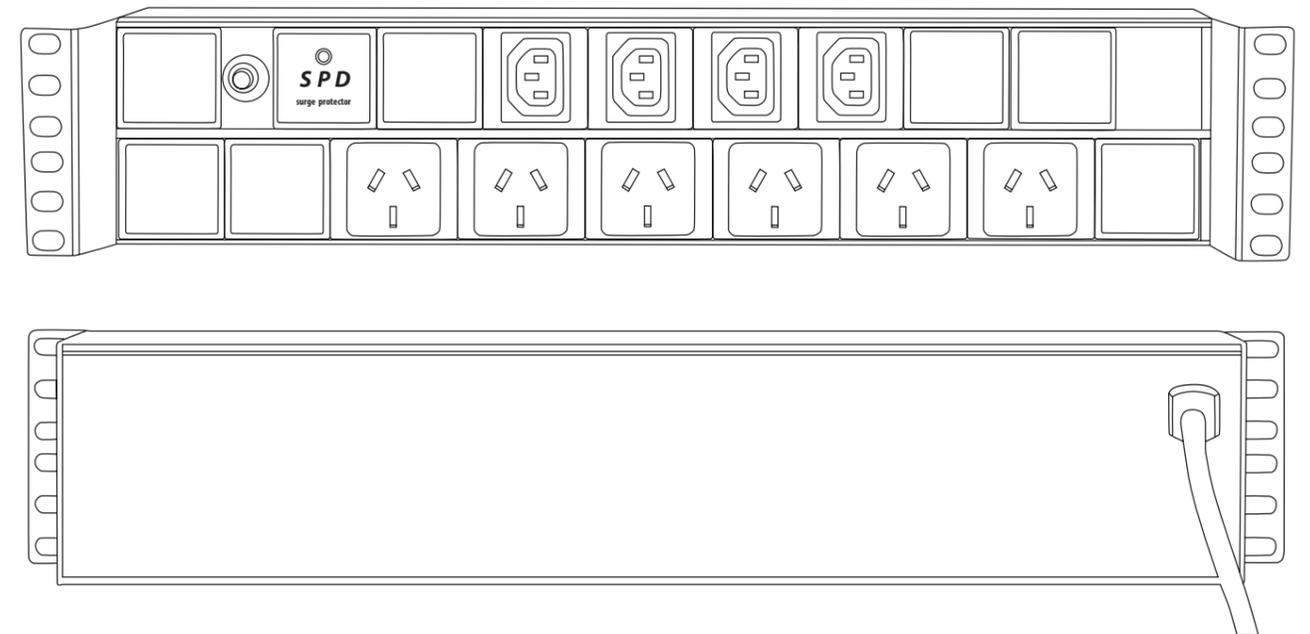


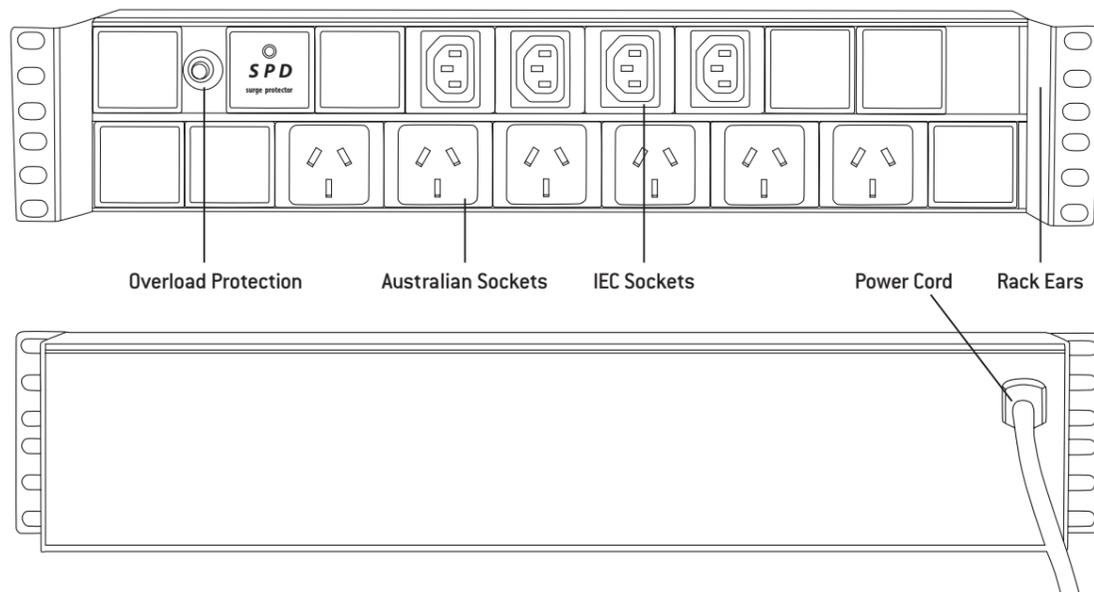
Rack Mounted Surge Protected 10 Way Power Board

User Manual



The neat solution to supplying mains power to your mounted equipment.
Simply screw this panel to your rack and plug the equipment in.
This model now offers surge protection for 10 power outlets
consisting of 4 IEC sockets and 6 Australian Main sockets.
Includes overload circuit breaker.

Installation

This power board is suitable for installation in a 19" horizontal rack. To install the power board to the rack we recommend using the following; M6 Captive Nuts (H5394, H 5395 or HC5396) and M6 Rack Bolts (H 5385A, H 5387A, H 5390A, H 5392A, HC5386B, HC5391B or HC5391B).

Safety

Please read the following information before installing or operating your rack power board.

⚠ DANGER

HAZARD OF ELECTRIC SHOCK, EXPLOSION, OR ARC FLASH

- This PDU is intended for indoor use only.
- Do not install this PDU where excessive moisture or heat is present.
- Never install any wiring, equipment, or PDUs during a lightning storm.
- Plug this PDU into a three-wire, grounded power outlet only. The power outlet must be connected to appropriate branch circuit/mains protection (fuse or circuit breaker). Connection to any other type of power outlet may result in a shock hazard.
- Do not use extension cords or adapters with this PDU.
- Check that the power cord, plug, and socket are in good condition.
- Disconnect the PDU from the power outlet before you install or connect equipment to reduce the risk of electric shock when you cannot verify grounding. Reconnect the PDU to the power outlet only after you make all connections.

Failure to follow these instructions will result in death or serious injury.

Altronic Distributors warrants this product for 12 months from date of purchase from Altronics or its resellers to the consumer. If this item is part of an installation or another product, please contact the installer or supplier for your warranty.

During the warranty period, we undertake to repair or replace your product at no charge if found to be defective due to a manufacturing fault. The warranty excludes damage by misuse or incorrect installation (i.e. failure to install and operate device according to specifications in the supplied instruction manual), neglect, shipping accident, or no fault found, nor by use in a way or manner not intended by the supplier.

For repair or service please contact your PLACE OF PURCHASE.

If this item was purchased directly from Altronics please make a warranty claim by:

1. FOR MAIL ORDER CUSTOMERS (includes school and trade orders),
 - a) Ringing us on 1300 797 007 and quoting your Tax invoice number.
 - b) Upon contacting Altronics, we will issue an R.A. (Return Authorisation). As Altronics have a number of service agents throughout Australia, a copy of the R.A. will be emailed, faxed or mailed to you with full instructions of how and where to send the goods. The freight for shipping goods back to Altronics for all repairs is at the customer's expense.
 - c) A copy of the R.A. form, (or at the very minimum, the R.A. number) must accompany the goods to effect the repair.
 - d) Altronics will pay the return freight to the customer where the warranty claim has been accepted.
 - e) Please quote the R.A. number in any correspondence to us.
2. FOR OVER THE COUNTER PURCHASES; to make a warranty claim, please return the goods to us in any of our stores, with a copy of your proof of purchase (tax invoice).
 - a) Upon leaving the goods at one of our stores, an R.A. (return authorisation) number will be issued to you.
 - b) Once repaired, you will be contacted, advising that the goods are ready to be collected from the store.

It is at Altronics discretion as to whether the goods will be repaired or replaced (whilst under warranty); and as to whether identical goods will be used to replace the item due to changes of models / products.

Note: Under no circumstances should you attempt to repair the device yourself or via a non-authorized Altronics service centre, as this will invalidate the warranty!

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
